



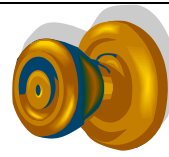
batch

A batch of cookies is the amount made from one recipe.



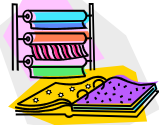
catch

A doorknob is used to latch a door shut.



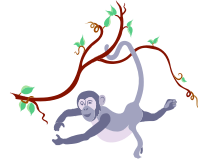
match

Decorators try to match colors and fabrics together.



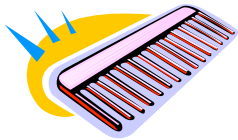
lamb

A wire comb and clippers are used to groom a dog.



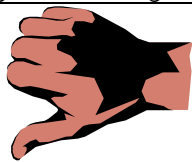
climb

Mount Everest is difficult to climb.



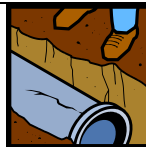
calf

A young cow is called a calf.



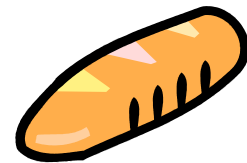
thumb

Some guitarists pick the strings with their thumb.



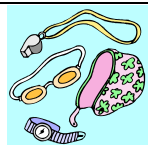
ditch
